



## ACCURATE BIBLE KNOWLEDGE!

**QUESTION:** "WHAT DO YOU DO WHEN TWO BIBLE VERSES 'COLLIDE'?"

**ANSWER:** "PUT THEM INTO SEPARATE BOXES"

### EXPLANATION:

(John didn't know why, but he put two and two together, realizing that giving the 'the kingdom of heaven' answer again, would just get himself shot)

**Clint:** "Correct! You want to go to the kingdom **IN** heaven not the kingdom of heaven. The latter no longer exists!"

Confused and relieved, a perplexed looking John then looks into the camera and whispers to the TV audience "Phew! That was close! I don't have a clue!"

**Clint:** "And don't you forget it. Christ came from the kingdom **in** heaven to set up the physical kingdom **of** heaven on earth with the impossible Sermon on the Mount rules that he would keep on Israel's behalf. Chalk and cheese John!"

### **CHRISTIANS DON'T KNOW 'ARTHUR FROM MARTHA' EITHER**

John, like 99.99% of today's 'Christians, didn't have a clue about the differences between the kingdom of heaven and the kingdom of God.

"What's this I'm burning! I'm in hell! This place doesn't exist! I believed this place didn't exist!"


