

"DEAR CHRISTIAN ... ARE YOU RIDING A MULE?"

"And Absalom met the servants of David. And **Absalom rode upon a mule**, and the **mule** went under the thick boughs of a **great oak**, and his head caught hold of the oak, and he was taken up between the heaven and the earth; and the mule that was under him went away." (<u>2 Samuel 18:9</u>)
