The following table explains the so-called different time frames:

Matthew 21:17-20	Mark 11:11-21
	SUNDAY 11 And Jesus entered into Jerusalem, and into the temple: and when he had looked round about upon all things,
SUNDAY NIGHT 17 And he left them, and went out of the city into Bethany; and he lodged there.	SUNDAY NIGHT and now the eventide was come, he went out unto Bethany with the twelve.
MONDAY MORNING 18 Now in the morning as he returned into the city, he hungered.	MONDAY MORNING 12 And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry:
19 And when he saw a fig tree in the way, he came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it,	¹³ And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet.
Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever.	¹⁴ And Jesus answered and said unto it, No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever. And his disciples heard it.
And presently the fig tree withered away.	DURING MONDAY 15 And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves; 16 And would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple. 17 And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves. 18 And the scribes and chief priests heard it, and sought how they might destroy him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine.
	MONDAY NIGHT 19 And when even was come , he went out of the city.

TUESDAY MORNING

²⁰ And when the disciples saw it, they marvelled, saying, How soon is the fig tree withered away!

TUESDAY MORNING

²⁰ And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots.

²¹ And Peter **calling to remembrance** saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away.


