

#12 "THE 'ORIGINALS' "
"Those weak in faith"

Dear Reader, the answers to all questions about this life are contained in **The Book of Life** called **The King James Bible**.

Question: Why do people still go on about 'the originals' this and 'the originals' that?

Answer: THEY ARE WEAK IN THEIR FAITH TOWARD GOD!

10. They **oppose** themselves and are **double minded** (2 Timothy 2:25; James 1:8)

(1 Corinthians 1:10)


Dear Reader how should we handle those of weaker faith?
