#### Christ throughout the Scriptures "SAMSON WAS A TYPE OF CHRIST"

#### PRECIS:

Dear Reader, Christ is to be found throughout the scriptures.

"Samson was a type of Jesus, who for the love of a harlot (and we are no better), was willing to part with his own strength; to be bound up by his own nation ([Judges 15:10-11](#)); to be delivered up to his enemies; to be blindfolded; to be made sport with; and put to death; yet by his death (like Samson) destroyed his enemies."

And he awoke out of his sleep, and said, I will go out as at other times before, and shake myself. And he wist not that the LORD was departed from him. <a href="#">Judges 16:20</a></p>	<p><b>4. Delivered up to his enemies</b></p> <p>"And while he yet spake, lo, <b>Judas</b>, one of the twelve, came, and with him <b>a great multitude</b> with swords and staves, from the chief priests and elders of the people." And when they had <b>blindfolded</b> him, they struck him on the face, and asked him, saying, Prophecy, who is it that smote thee?" (<a href="#">Luke 22:63-64</a>)</p>
<p><b>6. Made sport with</b></p> <p>And it came to pass, when their hearts were merry, that they said, Call for Samson, that he may make us sport. And they called for Samson out of the prison house; and <b>he made them sport</b>: and they set him between the pillars. <a href="#">Judges 16:25</a></p>	<p><b>6. Made sport with</b></p> <p>"And the men that held Jesus <b>mocked him, and smote him</b>. And when they had blindfolded him, they <b>struck him on the face</b>, and asked him, saying, Prophecy, who is it that smote thee? And <b>many other things blasphemously spake</b> they against him." (<a href="#">Luke 22:63-65</a>)</p> <p>"Then did <b>they spit in his face</b>, and <b>buffeted him</b>; and <b>others smote him</b> with the palms of their hands, Saying, Prophecy unto us, thou Christ, Who is he that smote thee?" ### 9. Destroyed his enemies

"And he found a new jawbone of an ass, and put forth his hand, and took it, and **slew a thousand men** therewith. And Samson said, With the jawbone of an ass, heaps upon heaps, with the jaw of an ass have I slain a thousand men." ([Judges 15:15-16](#))

"And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will seek to **destroy all the nations** that come against Jerusalem." ([Zechariah 12:9](#))

"Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might **destroy him** that had the power of death, that is, **the devil**;" ([Hebrews 2:14](#))

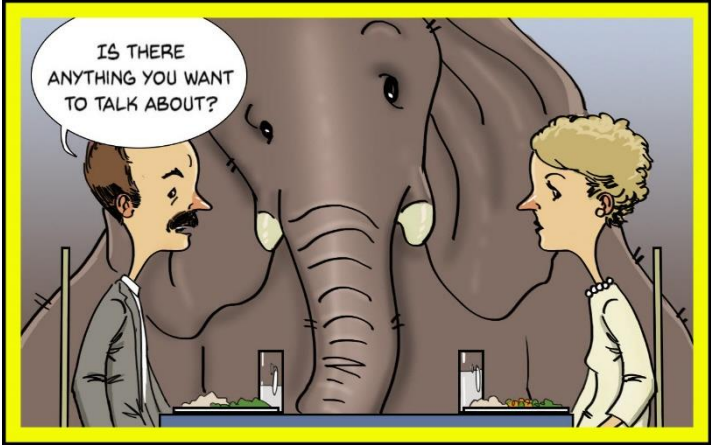
