

"WHEN TALKING TO A MUSLIM"

"In whom **the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not**, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. (2 Corinthians 4:4)

"And the servant of the Lord **must not strive**; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will." (2 Timothy 2:24-26)

"He that answereth a matter before he heareth it, it is folly and shame unto him." (Proverbs 18:13)

"Come now, and **let us reason together**, saith the LORD:..." (<u>Isaiah 1:18</u>).

POINTERS:

- 1. Deal with one topic at a time, to avoid jumping from one topic to another.
- 2. Be friendly
- 3. Don't interrupt
- 4. Don't criticize
- 5. **Do not strive**
- 6. Don't argue
- 7. Understand what they are saying

- 8. Invite comment to questions
- 9. Always be friendly
- 10. Use no other Bible but The King James Bible ... all other versions are corrupt.
- 11. When answering and talking use phrases such as

"That's a good question."

"If I was you, I would also want an answer to that question."

"I appreciate where you are coming from."

"This is a reasonable question and it needs a reasonable answer."

"This is what God Almighty says in his Bible ..." Come now, and **let us reason together**, saith the LORD:..." (<u>Isaiah 1:18</u>).

Saying these things helps identify you with the other ... but you are **not** agreeing with them.

Remember they have been blinded by the god of this world (2 Corinthians 4:4)

STANDARD QUESTIONS you can ask:

- 1. If you died tonight, where will you spend eternity heaven or hell?
- 2. Heaven? Why would God let you in?
- 3. What does the Koran teach about forgiveness?
- 4. May I show you what the Bible says about all this?

THE CHRISTIAN GOSPEL IS VERY SIMPLE:

All other religions say you get to heaven by good works.

Christianity is the only religion that says "It has **nothing** to do with our works.

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that **not of yourselves**: it is **the gift of God**: **Not of works**, lest any man should boast." (<u>Ephesians 2:8-9</u>)

Christ has shed his blood for all our sins ... past, present and **future** ... no more to pay ... it's called **redemption** ... "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;" (<u>Ephesians 1:7</u>)

Remission of sins (<u>Hebrews 9:22</u>) is only for sins that are **past** (<u>Romans 3:25</u>) ... and this is all animal blood could do under the Old Testament ... so they did it over and over and over again. But Christ's blood washes away all our sin debt (<u>Revelation 1:5</u>). It **redeems** us.

No more sacrifices needed. There remains no more sacrifice for sins (<u>Hebrews 10:26</u>).
